## School Uniform

As explained in a previous communication over the years, our uniform is incredibly important to us.

Item	Optional or required	Branding	How to acquire
Bottle green sweatshirt or Bottle green cardigan	Required	Branding is optional	*Branded sweatshirt and cardigan available from school supplier. Plain sweatshirts or cardigan can be bought from regular high street retailers.
White shirt or polo shirt	Required	Branding is optional	*Branded item available from school supplier. Plain polo shirts and shirts available from regular high street retailers.
Grey / black trousers, skirt or dress	Required	No branding and on an appropriate length	*Available from school supplier, second hand from school office and available from regular high street retailers.
Sensible black shoes	Required		Available from regular high street retailers.
Plain/dark tracksuit, jogging trousers or leggings and either sweatshirt or white/house colour t-shirt for outdoor PE	Required	Appropriate branding if necessary	Available from regular high street retailers.
School book bag	Optional	School logo	Available from school supplier.

\*The school swap shop is also available

We are resending this information as we have noticed a number of children, especially those in our older classes are still choosing NOT to wear our uniform. This is despite being reminded to wear uniform on a number of occasions. Sports kits and tracksuits everyday are not school uniform. KS2 children have been given permission to wear their PE kit on their PE days and on these days only.

Today, all the children have been told in assembly that deliberate rule breaking will result in children being given school uniform to wear and missing playtime. Our whole school ethos has always been about supporting families, but we must insist that our uniform is a non-negotiable aspect of our school life. All children are expected to attend in uniform unless they have medical or sensory needs that have been discussed with a member of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT).
