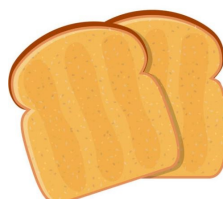


Changes to snacks at break times.

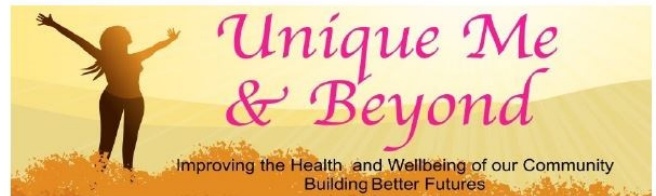
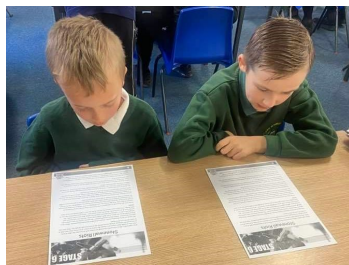
