Year 6 children will be undertaking the national curriculum assessments (SATs) in:

- English grammar, punctuation and spelling
- English reading
- Mathematics

The dates for the SATs this year are:

Date	Subject	Test papers
Monday 13 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling	Paper 1: Questions Paper 1: Spelling
Tuesday 14 May	English reading	English reading
Wednesday 15 May	Mathematics	Paper 1: Arithmetic Paper 2: Reasoning
Thursday 16 May	Mathematics	Paper 3: Reasoning

Year 6 is very demanding year for children as they revise and practice all the skills they have learnt throughout primary education. Parents can help and support their children through SATs by ensuring they get enough rest, healthy diet and lot's of downtime too.
