The Hub had a fantastic time making pancakes this week but most of all the children loved eating them!










Why not try and make some at home this half term!



# Make Pancakes

### Ford the Fox is hungry and would

- y mix the eggs into the flour with a fork or whisk

The event will take place at Barnsley Metrodome this half term.



#### Can you help Sophie Squirrel make this simple egg box bird feeder?

Use this simple winter activity to help feed the birds during the winter months.

- · Wool or string
- Scissors



- 1 Cut off the lid of the egg box so you are left with the bottom tray where
- Decorate your egg box using colouring pens. This is where you can be as creative as you like.
- If your egg box doesn't already have holes in the top, you might want to get the help of an adult to make the holes in the box for you.
- You now need to add the string or wool to your egg box so you can hang it outside. Take a piece of string, tie a knot in one end to stop it slipping through the hole, and feed the unknotted end through the first hole from underneath the box. Feed it back through the second hole from the top and tie a knot in the end, so it doesn't slip back through the second hole.
- Turning your bird feeder back up the correct way you can now fill it with seed and hang it outside.
