Children's Mental Health Week

Next week we are celebrating Children's Mental Health Week. The theme this year is **Let's Connect** encouraging and helping people to connect with others in a healthy, rewarding and meaningful way.

You could try some of the following ideas at home:

1. Connect with your child in everyday ways

Give them your full attention, chat, share music and talk about how your day has been.

2. Talk about important connections

Chat about neighbours, friends and family members who are near or far.

3. Talk to your children about their friends

Listen without judgement, encourage positive behaviour and relationships.

4. Connect by taking an interest in your child's world

Understanding your child's interests can help you feel connected to the important things in their world.

5. Find time to connect as a family

Life is busy and stressful, but setting time aside to connect as a family is important—you could cook and eat a meal together, watch a film, go for a walk or do the big shop together.

6. Try to resolve conflict and re-connect after arguments

Learning how to say sorry, making amends when they have done something wrong and how to disagree in appropriate ways are all important lessons for children to learn. Try to model the behaviour that you would like to see in your children. Remember, you are their greatest role model for behaviour.
