Classroom Organisation

In an effort to restrict the number of parents and children who are in the playground at any one time, we have resumed the staggered start and finish times that were implemented in September. Please can you stick to these start and finish times unless you have children in different classes in which case you should drop off at the earliest class opening time and collect at the latest time. Children who attend school unaccompanied (usually Y5 and Y6) should not arrive before their start time and should not meet up or congregate outside the school grounds.
